

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT TO COUNCIL June 21, 2021

ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS

- Cemetery operations
 - Purchasing a monument lifter to assist with leveling sunken headstones in the Groveport Cemetery
 - Leveling program will start later this summer
- Main Street aesthetic enhancements
 - Fire hydrant painting including Storz adapter installation Completed
 - Street light painting is in progress
 - Staff goal to complete before July 4th
 - Traffic signal painting Completed
- Professional development
 - None during May
- Roadside mowing
 - Replacement mower deck has been ordered and will be installed on the 1986 Ford tractor
- Sanitary sewer maintenance program
 - o May 2021
 - Video inspection 5,942 feet
 - Line cleaning 2,900 feet
- Sidewalk replacement program 2021
 - Contractor has been selected and authorized to start the work
 - o Harber Concrete is scheduled to start the sidewalk repairs in September
- Street tree maintenance
 - Staff is currently assessing recommendations to create a work list, including pruning and removal
 - Removal locations are being tracked to enable proper replacement in the fall
 - Staff is identifying locations where street trees are needed to restore consistency throughout the community
- Traffic sign replacement program 2021
 - o Replacement signs have been received and installation has begun along Main Street
- Water distribution maintenance
 - Staff completed flushing and draining of the fire hydrants on the Groveport water system
 - o In the fall, staff will flush and drain the hydrants on the Columbus water system
- Water plant gate replacement and electronic opener installation Completed
