

FACILITIES and PARKS STATUS

- The Parks Department is very busy getting caught up on grass cutting and other seasonal projects.
- The new fire and security systems are installed at the golf course. The old systems were beginning to fail and were not in compliance with current fire regulations. The system has been tested, inspected and approved.
- We are beginning the clean out and re-organization of the basement of the Municipal Building.
- The Parks Department has completed the planting of the annual flowers and several locations throughout the City
- New employee Brian Morse has been hired in the Facilities Department. Brian is a very talented maintenance tech and has also been lending a hand as needed with the Parks Department.
- The Facilities Department has been doing an assessment of all the facilities so that monthly, quarterly and annual projects can be stored and scheduled into the FMX system.
- The outdoor pool is filled and all new equipment installed. We will be completing all other projects and be ready to open on Saturday May 23rd. The opening went on as scheduled.
- We have completed two rain gardens, one at Heritage Park and one at Cruiser Park. Photos attached.
- The new surveillance system is 75% complete at the parking areas at the Rec Center. 12 cameras on poles in the parking lot as well as 4 cameras mounted on the exterior of the RC. The cameras will

monitor the lot because of recent vandalism. Expect completion by the end of the month.

- New exterior lighting has been installed at the Town Hall.
