On 5/5/26 second shift officers responded to Groveport Elementary on report of nude photos being sent between student's cellphones. After speaking with principal, students, and parents it was decided that the photos would be deleted and no further criminal investigation.

Lt. Short worked special duty detail for the Groveport Imagine Schools "graduation" on 5/20 and 21 to assist with traffic and parking.

Ofc. Herrera worked special duty for Madison Christian Schools graduation on May 22 to assist with security and parking issues.

May 2026 SRO Incidents

On 5/4 At Glendening elementary, I found an MSS student wondering in the parking lot, appearing confused. Student spoke very little English and the translation app had to be utilized. The student misunderstood the instruction to the office and left the school. Student believed that Glendening elementary was the office. Student was redirected, returned to school and the location of the office was pointed out to him. Code A

On 5/5 at Groveport Elementary a parent requested charges on a 10-year-old male student whom purposely assaulted her daughter via pencil to the hand. Parent wanted the situation documented for recording keeping purposes but has not provided me any info via email. Student disciplined by school admin. Prosecution declined. Code A

On 5/6 at MSS a teacher had a verbal altercation with a student which resulted in the student refusing any request by staff and disrupting class. Parties were separated and I was able to calm the student. Student was disciplined by school staff. Prosecution declined. Code A

On 5/7 at MSS a student told school admin that another student had a vape inside the bathroom. School admin searched student in question and only found an empty vape box. Student grew up, caused a scene and later disciplined by school admin. Prosecution declined. Code A

On 5/7 at MSS a special needs student trashed the bathroom because he was upset mom left him at the school. Staff was unable to calm the student down. I was contacted via phone by school admin for assistance. The student was emergency removed released to his parent. Code A

On 5/8 at MSS a fight between two female students occurred in the gym. Fight was deemed mutual and the students were disciplined by school admin. Prosecution Declined. Code A

On 5/8 at MSC a student reported that another student brought a pet gerbil to school and lost it. Parents were notified and later found the pet inside the students' pencil case. Student and gerbil were released to parent. No student policy violation occurred during this incident. Code A

On 5/9 at MSC it was reported to me after the fact that a large sized turtle was found on school grounds. Staff and student felt unsafe to participate in outside school activities. The turtle was UTL once on scene. Code A

On 5/11 at Groveport elementary a student from the emotion disturbance unit was reported running down Main St. First shift officers located the student. Student released to parent. Code A

On 5/18 at MSS a fight between two male students occurred in the gym. Fight was deemed mutual and the students were disciplined by school admin. Prosecution Declined. Code A

On 5/12 at MSC a student was told to go to the office, while walking to the office he left the school. Drone operator, Rossor, GPD Detectives and patrolman, along with Madison Twp. PD assisted in the search. Student was later located at the nearby park. School admin disciplined the student. Prosecution declined. Code R

On 5/13, 5/20 and 5/21, I assisted MSS admin during tornado, lockdown and fire drills.

On 5/21 at MSS a male student reported that another male student touched his buttocks after he told him to stop. Parents contacted and declined prosecution. Parents wanted the incident documented for record keeping purposes. Code R
