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A Few Reminders from Groveport Building & Zoning Department

Premises Identification – Homes and Buildings must have address numbers plainly legible and visible from the street. House and building numbers are convenient for finding addresses, but also required by City Ordinances and necessary for emergency responders. When responding to an emergency, minutes matter so be sure that fire, ambulance, police and city personnel can easily and quickly find your address. We recommend that all Groveport residents and businesses take a few moments to install house/building numbers or examine existing numbers to ensure that the numbers are easily read from the street.

Please consider the following: • Script numbers or numbers that are spelled out in words can be difficult to read quickly from the street. • Brass or bronze numbers are difficult to see. Use numbers that contrast with the background. • If the house is located more than 45 feet from the street, the numbers should be displayed on a fence, mailbox, or other appropriate place that will make it visible for approaching vehicles. • Be sure that the view of the numbers is not obstructed by shrubs, trees, or decorations, such as flags. • Numbers should be clearly visible when approaching from either side of the house.

Additionally, as warmer weather approaches, we would like to take this opportunity to remind our citizens and businesses of a few of our maintenance and zoning requirements:

- Grass, weeds or plant growth must be cut regularly and maintained so as not to reach or exceed 10" in height.
- Garage or Home Sales – Permits are required. Please contact the Municipal Building at 614-836-5301 to obtain applications and additional information.
- Fences, Decks, Sheds and Swimming Pools – Permits are required. Please contact the Building and Zoning Department at 614-830-2045 or online at www.groveport.org to obtain permit applications and additional information before installing.
- Signs – Permits are required. Please contact the Building and Zoning Department at 614-830-2045, to obtain permit applications and additional information before installing.

Is Your Ankle Playing Tricks on You?

Ankle sprains happen. Athletes learn the concepts of P.R.I.C.E. (Protect, Rest, Ice, Compression, Elevation) early in their career as a way to manage acute (recent) injuries with swelling and pain. General guidelines are that an athlete should not return fully to play until swelling has resolved, and they can perform multiple repetitions of sport-specific activities without an increase in pain or swelling. But sometimes ankle sprains keep happening, and an athlete can spend an entire season dealing with one ankle sprain after another. Athletes may call it a trick ankle; doctors call it recurrent ankle sprains. Therapists call it decreased proprioception (balance), and it is treatable.

Balance is a skill just like free throws, juggling, throwing, or any other sport skill. Just like any other skill, you can improve your balance by practicing it. In rehabilitation, proprioception is trained by strengthening the muscles surrounding the ankle, and by working the ankle's sensors.


