National Police Week is to honor the service and sacrifice of the law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities; and

WHEREAS:

there are approximately 800,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Groveport Police Department; and

WHEREAS:

in 2021, 472 Peace Officers died in the line of duty nationwide, ten of those Peace Officers died in Ohio; and

WHEREAS:

the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers' Memorial in Washington D.C.; and

WHEREAS:

this administration joins in this special tribute to acknowledge all Ohio officers who have given the supreme sacrifice -their livesin defense of the citizens of Ohio.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, LANCE WESTCAMP, Mayor of the City of Groveport, Ohio, do hereby proclaim:

MAY 11 through MAY 17, 2022 AS NATIONAL POLICE WEEK and MAY 15, 2022 AS NATIONAL PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY

in memory and respect of those officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty. I do hereby declare that all flags are to fly at half-staff on May 15, 2022, throughout the City of Groveport.
