Recreation Manager Interviews

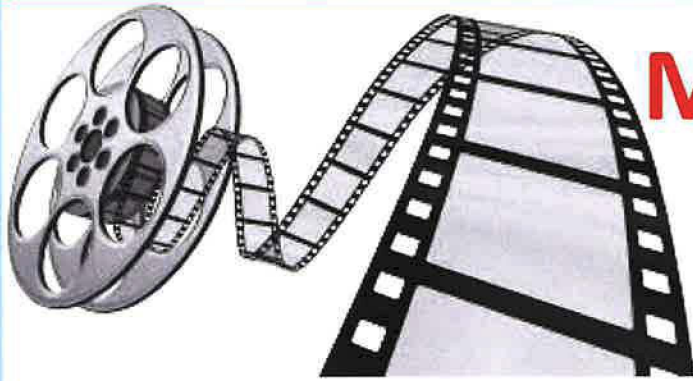
Staff is in the process of scheduling second interviews for the top two candidates.

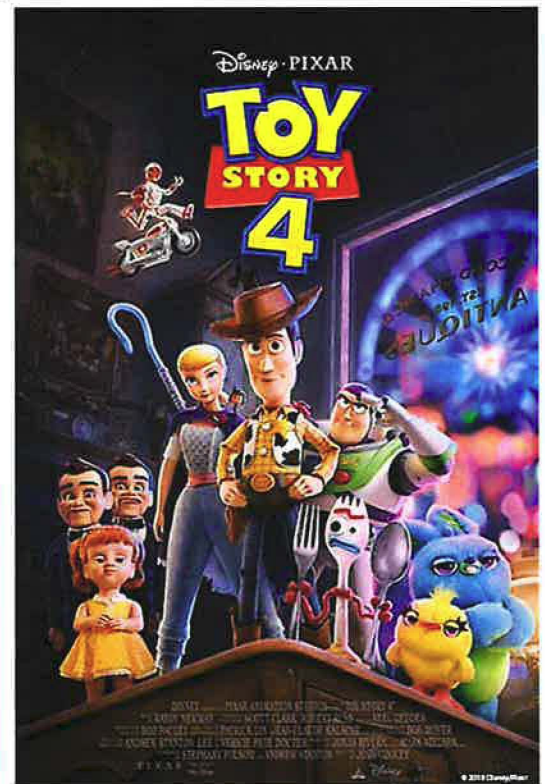

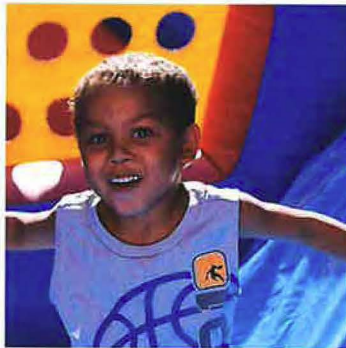
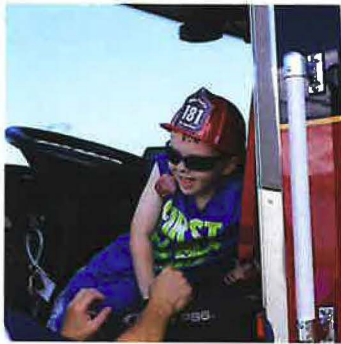
