Work activities since last report have included water main, sanitary sewer main and storm sewer construction, along Main St. and sanitary sewer in Wirt Rd. A third abandoned tank was discovered within the Main St. travel lane and it was removed; no soil contamination was found. Other work undertaken included installation of parking lot storm sewers and catch basins, curb underdrains, utility and traffic signal wire duct bank along Main street and removal of pavements and subgrade compaction.

Construction work expected in next few weeks is expected to include the following:

- Curb and gutter construction at the new Main St/Wirt Rd intersection
- Substantial completion of sanitary sewer construction (testing will follow)
- Subgrade prep and paving of intermediate course on Main St.
- Street-light foundation and lighting equipment
- School drive approach pavement replacement and replacement of pavement on Main St. pull-off lane in front of Elementary School
- Reopening of Main St. to two-way, two lane traffic
- Phase 1A parking lot work, including prep of subgrade, installation of conduit and electric
- Removal of dewatering system

2026 Street Maintenance Program

Work on the following alleys was performed, including removal of pavements, subgrade prep, and placement of intermediate asphalt course:

- Hilly Alley (south of Cherry St to Canal St),
- Shoemaker Alley (College to Center St),
- Raver Alley (Main south to Canal St),
- Buckeye Alley (College St to Walnut St).

Work on Madison Lane begins in a phased approach, on Sunday 7/19 (weather permitting), when pavements will be removed and pavement reconstruction will be performed in areas south of the Township Community Center Driveway. Areas north of the Center will occur in a later phase that extends work toward the Firehouse Lane intersection. Work activities are being coordinated with the Township Administration, and Township Police and Fire Departments to maintain access/egress from their facilities.

Pavement repairs on Greenpointe Dr South and at the Groveport Park lower parking lot and Park walking paths will occur later in the summer
