• Capital Projects:

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2024 Street Maintena program	nce Bids were received on March 7, 2024. Three competitive bids were received, all all within 10% of the Engineer's estimate. Notice of Award is being prepared. At the Committee of the Whole meeting, Council will be advised of the contractor who will be receiving the award notice and a confirmation of the scope of work.
Pickle Ball Courts	Contract has been awarded to and entered into with Miles-McClellan Construction Company. The "Notice to Proceed" was issued on March 14, 2024, and a Preconstruction meeting was held on this same date. The Scope of Work includes the Base bid and Alternate, which together includes an 8-court facility over 2,400 square yards, nets, finished court surface treatment, fencing, 600 SY concrete patio, sidewalks, water service and a water drinking fountain, shade structures, electrical circuits, electrical receptacles, and light poles and luminaires. Mobilization to the field to begin work may start as soon as March 25. Construction updates will be provided as work progresses.
Heavy Hauls	As we've all seen, the first of several heavy haul/super loads have occurred in our jurisdiction on March 9 and 10. The next haul, which left Manchester Ohio on March 14, is expected to arrive in our jurisdiction on March 23/24. ODOT has created an "About the Superload" information website, which is as follows:
