


City Administrator Report to Council Council Meeting BJ King, City Administrator June 8, 2020

Administrative items

Trash contract survey – The community survey for the various trash and recycling collections services ended on May 29th. We received 269 responses. Remaining "status quo" for trash and recycling collection received the most support, with 50.1% of respondents choosing this option. The next most supported, with 28.62% responses, was maintaining "status quo" for trash collection and implementing the wheeled recycling carts.

- **Street trees** We have received two price quotes to remove trees located at:
 - o 215 Front Street Large hole in trunk that collects water and rots
 - o 235 Front Street Maple tree has a dying root system and decay in the crown
 - 197 Front Street Ash tree has dying root system
 - o 173 Front Street Maple tree roots removed for sidewalk repair
 - o 537 Elm Street Tree is dead and immediate removal is recommended
 - o 545 Elm Street Tree has dying root system and dead limbs/decay in crown

The quotes are in the amounts of \$10,300 and \$14,100. Assuming we proceed with removal of the trees for safety, residents would be notified to explain why the trees are being removed. Additionally, we would talk to an arborist about planting trees on Front Street to replace those that were removed.
