For July 2016

From the Chief:

July 4th 2016 all our officers worked the event, with the exception of Capt. Blevins and Officer Guiler who were on sick leave. The main areas of responsibility for the police department were regular patrol, security the night before, parade, and fireworks. Between 6pm July 3rd to midnight July 4th our officers worked approximately 300 hours. Being a holiday this was all at overtime rate. There were 89 hours of the overtime that officers converted to comp earned.
