City Administrator Report to Council City Council BJ King, City Administrator March 22, 2021

Legislative items

- Ord. 2021-012 Amendment to Codified Ordinance 126

At the March 22nd Council meeting, an ordinance to amend Codified Ordinance 126 (Bid Standards) will be introduced for consideration. The amendment would add the consideration for contractors to be ODOT pre-gualified. The ODOT pre-gualification would become a consideration for determining how responsible a contractor is. This request arose due to the Bixby Road reconstruction project. The County plans to replace a large culvert under Bixby Road prior to the road being resurfaced. Our project and the County's culvert project will be bid as one package to increase competitiveness and help with project coordination. The County uses the ODOT prequalification requirement as part of their bid review process. They requested that we include the pre-qualification criteria as part of this project. The amendment will be written in a way that the pre-qualification requirement will be determined on a project-by-project basis. This will also be helpful if/when we are awarded federal funding, as the ODOT pre-qualification is a requirement for any federally funded projects. To maintain the project schedule, and in order to get the project advertised for bid, the Administration will request this code amendment be approved as an emergency measure.

Additionally, since an amendment to Codified Ordinance 126 is being considered, the Administration took this opportunity to also update the code be consistent with our current staffing structure and operating procedures. A redlined version of the proposed amendments is attached to Ordinance 2021-012.
