• Outdoor Pool Opening:

On Saturday May 27th we successfully opened the outdoor pool to the public. The Groveport Fighting Fish swim team also started their season on Tuesday May 30th. We look forward to another great pool season.

• May Lifeguard Classes:

In May we offered two lifeguard classes. There were 24 people that were registered between both classes. This was one of the highest turnouts we have had for our lifeguard certification course. This was successful due to the increase in lifeguard pay and a successful recruiting plan from our human resources department and our aquatic manager, Kelsey Valine.
