### **Capital Projects:**

2023 Street Maintenance Program

All work is substantially completed on the program. Some punch list items

are to be addressed.

SR 317 at Rohr Rd

This is a Franklin County Engineer's Office project. The intersection opened on October 3.

Port Road Phase 2 A presentation is to be made to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) District 3 Integrating Committee for the application. Project if funded, will include reconstruction of the pavement section and other ancillary items on Port Road from Speigel Dr. to Rohr Rd. Final outcome of application will be discovered in early December 2023.

### **Traffic Counts**

Now that the Round-About is opened, traffic counts are scheduled to be taken in a few Roadway corridors to serve as data for analysis in relevant traffic studies. Areas include along the Wirt Road corridor at a few intersections, at and west of Main Street, and the intersection of Ebright Rd at Bixby Road. More of this will/can be discussed at Committee of the Whole meeting.

## **Development Projects:**

Redwood Apts. Hendron Site construction continues. Installation of the public water main extension

and sewer main along the roadway frontage is complete. Building

construction still is proceeding.

Hendron Rd Animal Hospital Site work is underway.

## Other:

ODOT District 6 meeting

Myself, Brian Strayer and BJ King met with ODOT staff at District 6 last week, on October 5, to discuss ODOT's Urban Paving program, which has changed significantly over the last 10-years, and as it will pertain to future resurfacing of SR 317. Information was provided to help guide the City for future budget planning for the City's responsible portion of cost to resurface the roadway. A complete resurfacing of SR 317 was last undertaken in 2013.
