- Legislation

Water Service Agreement with Columbus – We have still not received the draft agreement. However, we were informed that the delay is because we currently do not have an emergency use agreement and Columbus needed to include that language into our service agreement. They will not require a formal extension to our current agreement as long as we continue to actively work toward the new agreement.

Water and Sewer Regulations – We have reviewed the current regulations and are providing you with updates based on our review. Included in the review was the Law Director, Assistant Administrator, Chief Building Official, Accounting/Water Billing Clerk and myself. This should be referred to the Committee of the Whole. At the committee meeting I will provide you with a list of proposed changes to the regulations.

Resolution Accepting the Budget Amounts – As Jeff Green indicated at your Committee of the Whole meeting this will need to be adopted at tonight’s meeting in order to return it to Franklin County on time.

- Water Tank Painting

I have requested cost estimates for various painting alternatives associated with Warren Motts’ request for the museum to be recognized on the tank when painted next Spring. I will provide Council with information when received.

- Residential Tire Collection

A tire collection event will be held in conjunction with Madison Township through SWACO’s program on October 18 from 8am to noon in the gravel lot at the recreation center. SWACO pays for the roll offs, we pay Liberty Tire for the tires collected **from our residents**, then SWACO reimburses us up to \$500. We will require those entering the event to provide us with resident information, then they will be directed to either the township’s roll off or ours. Four passenger vehicle tires per household will be the maximum. The event will close once the roll offs are filled if prior to noon. There will not be a lot of advertisement about this event in order to discourage residents outside the area from coming. Information will be provided on the upcoming Local Waste bills.
