## **ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS**

- Cemetery operations
  - Headstone leveling program will start in the fall
- Main Street aesthetic enhancements
  - o Fire hydrant painting including Storz adapter installation Completed
  - Street light painting Completed
  - o Traffic sign replacement program 2021 Completed
  - o Traffic signal painting Completed
- Mosquito control program
  - o Year to date ten rounds including one by Franklin County Public Health
- National Clean Up Day September 18<sup>th</sup>
  - o Fifty one volunteers attended
  - o One hundred seven bags of trash collected
- Professional development
  - Director & Superintendent met with consultant to develop snow & ice control training to be held on October 18<sup>th</sup>
- Sanitary sewer maintenance program year to date
  - o One hundred sixty seven manholes have been inspected
  - o Fifteen manhole lids have been replaced to comply with EPA standards
  - o Approximately sixty manholes require additional maintenance
- Sidewalk replacement program 2021
  - o Harber Concrete completed the sidewalk repairs in September, including restorations
- Street tree maintenance
  - Started maintenance activities on the top one hundred trees based on the Priority Tree
    Maintenance Listing created by Davey Resource Group
    - Staff began removing thirty five hazardous trees throughout the community
    - Currently working on the replacement tree planting list for the fall season
    - Waiting on price quotes from two certified arborists for pruning sixty five trees
