ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS

- Cemetery operations
 - Headstone leveling program will start in the fall
- Main Street aesthetic enhancements
 - Fire hydrant painting including Storz adapter installation - Completed
 - Street light painting - Completed
 - Traffic sign replacement program 2021 - Completed
 - Traffic signal painting - Completed
- Mosquito control program
 - Year to date ten rounds including one by Franklin County Public Health
- National Clean Up Day September 18th
 - Fifty one volunteers attended
 - One hundred seven bags of trash collected
- Professional development
 - Director & Superintendent met with consultant to develop snow & ice control training to be held on October 18th
- Sanitary sewer maintenance program – year to date
 - One hundred sixty seven manholes have been inspected
 - Fifteen manhole lids have been replaced to comply with EPA standards
 - Approximately sixty manholes require additional maintenance
- Sidewalk replacement program 2021
 - Harber Concrete completed the sidewalk repairs in September, including restorations
- Street tree maintenance
 - Started maintenance activities on the top one hundred trees based on the Priority Tree Maintenance Listing created by Davey Resource Group
 - Staff began removing thirty five hazardous trees throughout the community
 - Currently working on the replacement tree planting list for the fall season
 - Waiting on price quotes from two certified arborists for pruning sixty five trees
