- When call button is pressed PD staff can see who is at the door via video feed on their desktop computer.

- Calls will automatically transfer to Franklin County Dispatch in the event no one is on-site to answer.

# Back-Ups

- Currently waiting for Microsoft Server Licensing.
- Storage appliance has been racked at the PD.
- Once licensing has been obtained, the operating system and backup software can be installed on the server.

## New Email with O365

- Migration has been completed.
- Cutover will take place on Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Final sync will take place after cutover to transfer any emails sent and received after the initial migration took place.
