• Eyes on the Pie 5K:

O We successfully launched our first ever Eyes on the Pie 5K Turkey Trot on Thanksgiving Day. We had 55 participants and everyone received a T Shirt and pie for participating. It was a great race, and we will be working on a yearly racing series in the future. Our goal next year is to double the registration of the race.

• City of Grove City Tour:

We gave a tour of the facility to several City of Grove City department heads and bond/levy committee chairs on December 3rd. They are in the process of exploring building a Rec Center and asked for a tour of our facility for the stakeholders that are involved in the process.

• Meetings:

- Private Lesson/Personal Training Meeting: Meeting to discuss streamlining processes for both private lessons and personal training sessions. Changes were implemented to both to make it easier to sell and track.
- Columbus Crew: Meeting with the Columbus Crew to discuss partnering with them on our upcoming spring soccer program. This would be similar to the current Jr. Cav's program.
- Temporary Emergency Shelter: Meeting to discuss identifying the Groveport Rec and Senior Center as an emergency shelter for the community.
