Administrative items

2021 Operating and Capital Appropriations Budget

The 2021 Operating and Capital Appropriations Budget has been completed. Individual department budget meetings were held the week of September 21st. Ever department did a good job of reducing their proposed 2021 expenditures. You will receive a copy of the budget on Monday evening at the Council Meeting. I look forward to our budget discussion during the October 19th Committee of the Whole meeting. Accompanying the budget is a memo from me that summarizes the budget. A first reading of the budget ordinance is scheduled for Monday's Council meeting.

- ODOT Salt Bid Ordinance

A first reading of an ordinance to authorize participation in the annual ODOT road salt bid is on Monday's meeting agenda. Typically, this ordinance would be presented to Council for consideration earlier in the year. However, due to the interruptions caused by Covid-19, the ordinance is delayed this year. We have ordered 500 tons of salt for the upcoming winter. Our cost per ton of salt is \$64.41. This ordinance will have all three readings.
