Legislation

Authorize Administrator to Bid and Execute Contracts for the Hendron Road Reconstruction Project (3rd Reading)

This is the OPWC funded project to reconstruct Hendron Road. The project will be bid later this year and construction will take place in 2017.

Accept Rohr Road Widening as Public Improvement (3rd Reading)

This is to accept the public improvements to the Rohr and Pontius street intersection completed and paid for by the developers of the southeast corner development.

Accept Rohr One Development, Phase 2 Waterline Improvements (3rd Reading)

This is to accept the 12” and 8” waterlines along Rohr Rd. and Commerce Center Dr. that were completed for Phase 2 of the Rohr One development.

2017 Appropriations (2nd Reading)

Appropriations as recommended by Council at Oct. 17 Committee of the Whole meeting.

Authorization to Enter into a Lease Agreement for the Purchase of Golf Cart Fleet (1st Reading)

As discussed at the Oct. 17 meeting, we are requesting that this be adopted tonight as emergency legislation so that the fleet can be advertised, ordered and delivered prior to the beginning of the golf season in 2017.

Increase of Rainy Day Fund Allocation and Maximum and Increase of Debt Service Fund (1st Reading)

As recommended by Council, the Rainy Day Fund annual allocation will be increased from \$100,000 to \$150,000 and the fund maximum will be increased from \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000. The Debt Service Fund will be increased from 15% of the net Income Tax revenue to 20%.

Amend the Position of Personnel Coordinator to Personnel Director (1st Reading)

As recommended in the 2017 Appropriations. We would like to fill this position Feb; 2017 due to the upcoming retirement of the current Personnel Coordinator.

Add Grounds Maintenance Worker I Position to Parks/Facilities Department (1st Reading)

As recommended in the 2017 Appropriations. We would like to fill this position shortly after the first of the year so that the new employee is fully trained prior to Spring’s busy period.
