Council Report:

04/10/19

- Several new directives, protocols and precautionary measures have been issued within the Police Department in response to the pandemic. Most are temporary in nature but all policies and protocols will be considered for future implementation and responses to pandemics.
- Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) Supply:
 - Approximately 300 Level 3 Procedure masks
 - Approximately 20 N95 Level masks
 - 3 Respirator Type masks / with filters
 - 4 Tyvek Suits
 - 27 Donated (replaceable filtered) 3D printed facemasks
 - Nitrile examination gloves / varying sizes 1,000+
 - Orders for PPE are being placed or have been placed to replace and expand our supplies. We expect most of this equipment to be backlogged however and will continue to explore alternatives and other sources.
- All Officers are on their normal schedules and have started bike patrol and foot patrols around town.
- Very few complaints about gatherings of 10 or more. Officers encountering juveniles gathering together are telling them to disperse and go home.
- Several surrounding jurisdictions, including ours were recently affected by a group of thieves rummaging through unlocked vehicles in our neighborhoods.
- The three new hires have been assigned a temporary shift to garner experiences on each shift:
 - Officer Shellie Rimmer is on 3rd Shift. She is also on stand-by with the Ohio National Guard. She is in her Sergeants Phase of Field Training.

- Officer John Westhoven is on 1st Shift and has completed his Field Training.
- All new Officers will be on a 1 year probationary period from their date of hire.
- The Groveport community is responding to this crisis well and in a civil fashion. The Groveport Police Department has received several donated supplies of masks. Several Officers have also responded to citizens needs above and beyond by buying toilet paper and water to those who need it. We are continuing to provide high visibility and professional services and are continuing to take strict precautionary measures for our protection.
