As I mentioned in previous reports, the speed measuring devices have been an asset to helping us monitor locations within the city limits, and then giving accurate vehicle counts and speed data when we receive citizen complaints. These devices have drawn attention by our community members, which then posted on social media questions and some inaccurate information on the intent of these devices. The Groveport Police Department was requested to give some information on the speed measuring devices by a reporter from NBC Channel 4, and Ptl. Josh Dillard handled the news story in a professional manner that gave our community and the TV viewers a better understanding of what these devices accomplish by being posted around the community.


#### New Officers Update-

The three new officers (*Ptl. Ryan Snider; Ptl. Joey Collins & Ptl. Patrick Buttress*) that were hired at the end of 2024 have now been working for the City of Groveport for 6 months. The three patrol sergeants have completed a mid-probationary period review of all three officers on their probationary period, and all three officers have met and/or exceeded our expectations during their reviews. I can also report that I have only heard positive aspects of all three officers patrol performance in the field, and their interactions with the community have produced several compliments by our officers and community members that the new officers have interacted with.

#### Patrol Sergeant Opening-

With the retirement of Sgt. Josh Guiler in late May, the Groveport Police Department has been working with the Personnel Department to creating a promotional process to identify candidates inside and outside the police department. The candidates have gone through a written examination and an assessment center evaluation during the month of June, and in late July Mayor Westcamp will be holding interviews with the top 6 candidates as the final step in the promotional process.
