



PUBLIC SERVICE DEPARTMENT REPORT TO COUNCIL

DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES – FEBRUARY 2023

- Assist Golf personnel hauling 12 loads of brush to compost facility
- Manhole and valve box protection rings were installed to prevent damage during snow operations
- Meetings – Public Service Director
 - Central Ohio American Public Works Association (COAPWA) monthly board meeting
 - Events Committee, including Fourth of July event discussions
 - Individual maintenance staff discussions
 - Met with property owner, George Simeon regarding drainage along Lowery Court
 - Met with Kevin Shannon regarding the 384 Westport Drive property sale
 - Outdoor Aquatic Center pool preparation & lazy river renovation discussions
 - Oversize load transportation meeting
- Municipal Building – landscape & irrigation renovations began
- OUPS 811 Service – located city owned underground utility infrastructure for 162 tickets
- Police Department interior remodeling and reconfiguring room usage
- Public Service facility – emergency lighting was installed in offices and garage area
- Received notice our applications for Tree City USA, including a Growth Award were approved
- Roadside mowing tractor ordered
- Sanitary sewer operations
 - 26 manhole lids were replaced to comply with current EPA standards
 - Located and inspected 8 manholes
 - 4 manholes were raised to grade for accessibility
 - Cleaned and video inspected 418 feet of sewer pipe
- Snow & ice control – Season total – 6 events = \$79,162.98
 - February 2023 – no events
- Storm sewer operations –
 - 13 storm drain inlets were visually inspected and cleaned
 - Cleaned and video inspected 2,639 feet of sewer pipe
 - 9 storm drains repaired
- Street light maintenance – repaired 7 street lights
- Surplus auction preparations began
- Traffic sign replacement program – 102 signs & 30 poles were replaced
- Tree removal at 111 Church St –removal of large tree started, but contractor waiting on larger equipment to complete – still in progress
- Veterans Park– section location bricks were installed and creation of database of veteran bricks continued
- Water operations – cleaning and rehabilitation of the south well was completed
