

FACILITIES and PARKS STATUS

March 21, 2016

- New window on the south side of the clubhouse at the golf course has been engineered and ordered for installation by the end of March. The window will add sunlight and scenery to the bar area.
- Painting has started in the Town Hall. The entire interior will be painted with a new color scheme.
- New counter has been installed on the first floor of the Town Hall. The counter replaces a very old and worn counter.
- The Madison Township Fire Department has inspected the Municipal Building, Police Department, Town Hall and Kid Space. The MTFD was invited to inspect our facilities so we would know if we had any violations. We had a few but did very well overall.
- The Parks Department is busy ordering Spring materials and we will be ready as soon as the weather breaks.
- The Facilities Department has been doing an assessment of all the facilities so that monthly, quarterly and annual projects can be stored and scheduled into the FMX system. **This project is ongoing.**
- We have begun the new building project at the water plant site. The first phase is the demo of the three old facilities and the cleanup of the site. A time line will be set after the utilities are disconnected and asbestos testing is complete. We have

disconnected the utilities and we expect demo to take place in a month or so. **Work continues**

- Roof work on the Town Hall is now complete and we are confident that this will alleviate all the water infiltration issues in the rear stairwell.
- The mild winter has allowed for more than average work to be done in the city parks. Work includes pothole repair, sign repair, clean out creeks and drainage, raking mulch in playgrounds cutting pompus grass and cutting brush back at Palm Pond.

Work continues

- The community garden has been tilled and will be ready for the spring growing season.
- The green house has been cleaned out and organized so that we will be ready for the annual flower planting project.
- The Mayor and City Attorney have traded office locations in the Municipal Building, this move is complete.
- We have been very busy in the Rec Center completing many overdo projects.
