Senior Center Council Report May 2021

May brought much change to the Senior Center! The state of Ohio, Ohio Department of Aging and Franklin County Public Health lifted many of the restrictions for Senior Centers and Adult Day Centers which allowed us to open our doors to limited activities at Groveport Senior Center. We continue to implement a phased re-opening plan that will allow us to gradually bring back all the programs and activities that the members of the center know and love in a safe and controlled way.

Masks are no longer mandated if members and guests are fully vaccinated. We no longer need to screen people as they come in to the facility. We continue to communicate safety protocols and best practices to our members and guests in regard to Covid-19.

Activities

- Our Zoom craft club for May was the last that we will do via Zoom. In June, we will bring back our monthly craft club as an in person activity. This activity is sponsored by Wesley Ridge Retirement Communities.
- Senior Chair Volleyball is every Tuesday and Friday at 1:00pm. Chair volleyball has moved back into the multipurpose room connected to the Senior Center.
- Card games have resumed 3 days a week.
- Billiards play twice a week.
- We are offering an instructor led art/craft activity each Thursday morning at 9:30.
- Book club begins on June 8th.
- Two time slots for social engagement are scheduled each week. We are offering a coffee social each Wednesday morning called "Lock 22 Café".
- In June and July, we will be holding space for members to bring a lunch in and enjoy eating together each Thursday at 12:00.
