Legislation

Lease Agreement with the Groveport Heritage and Preservation Society for the Groveport Heritage Museum in Town Hall (3rd Reading) - As previously discussed, the previous lease has expired.

Modification of the Hunting Map (2nd Reading) – Map is primarily changing because Metro Parks has requested that their property be shown on the hunting map as to not permit hunting on their properties.

Prohibit Food Vendors from Setting Up on Private Property during a City Event (2nd Reading) – We wish to prohibit food vendors who sit up on private property during City sponsored events.

OPBA Contract (1st Reading) – This is the contract for the Police Department Sergeants. There are no changes to the terms discussed in our recent executive session. We are requesting that Council adopt this emergency legislation at tonight’s meeting. The agreement is retroactive to July 1, 2015.

Hendron Road Improvement Project to OPWC for Funding (1st Reading) – We are requesting that Council adopt this legislation at tonight’s meeting. The funding request deadline is Sept. 14.

West Bixby Road Pavement Rehabilitation, Phase 1 (1st Reading) - We are requesting that Council adopt this legislation at tonight’s meeting. The funding request deadline is Sept. 14.

Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (1st Reading) – This resolution will adopt the plan we discussed at the August Committee of the Whole meeting. We need to submit this to OPWC with our funding applications noted above, so we are requesting adoption of this at tonight’s meeting.

Use Variance for 595 Cherry Street (1st Reading) – This use variance is being submitted by the City for use as a food pantry. The previously approved lease agreement has been sent to the food pantry for their review.
