 - 375 gallons of liquid ice melt applied, totaling \$198.75
 - 74 bags of ice melt, totaling \$1,295.00
 - 411.25 labor hours, totaling \$15,067.96
 - 283 truck & equipment hours, totaling \$13,996.19
- Storm sewer operations 67 storm drain inlets were visually inspected
- Street sweeping removed 10 cubic yards of debris
- Tree removal at 111 Church St –removal of large tree started, but contractor needs larger equipment to complete still in progress
