

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT TO COUNCIL December 14, 2020

## **ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS**

- Professional development
  - Mike Schweinsberg and Jim Roe are currently attending training courses in hopes of acquiring OEPA water certifications
  - o OEPA approved Brian Strayer's application for Water Distribution Class 1 certification
- Sanitary sewer maintenance program
  - As of December 1, 2020 77 sections, totaling 15,741 feet of sewer line have been cleaned and video inspected
  - o The inspected sections have been overall in good condition
  - o Problem areas are being prioritized for work completion in 2021
- Storm sewer maintenance program
  - o City contractor is beginning the line cleaning and video inspection program
- Leaf collection program
  - o Completed Friday December 11th
  - o Leaf collection program went very smooth with very few complaints
  - o Total of 33 loads at approximately 780 cubic yards were collected
- Tree removal and replacement program
  - o Several dead Ash trees along Rohr Rd have been scheduled for removal this Fall
- FMX work order management program
  - Working with programmers to expand the use and capabilities for scheduling, tracking and reporting of work orders and requests for service
  - o Maintenance staff are currently being trained on its use
- Snow and ice control
  - Snow plow and salt spreader have been ordered to install on 2015 stake body dump truck.
    This will be used as a spare snow truck.
- Installed two large tv screens in garage area to enable better social distancing during virtual meetings and trainings. The first training, trench safety, went very well regarding social distancing.
