ADMINISTRATION – *Marsha Hall*

- Status of on-going projects
 - Spiegel Drive reconstruction – *Project completed*
 - Town Center project – Notice to Proceed issued; AEP work scheduled
 - Safe Routes to School Travel Plan – ODOT to schedule engineer recommendation
 - Port Rd. reconstruction – Columbia Gas relocation scheduled
 - Water Meter Project – *Meter installation has started; about ¼ customers have set appointments for installation*
 - Water Treatment Plant – PTI application was sent to OEPA; Bids in November
 - Police Building/MB Improvements – *beginning purchase orders*
 - 173 Front St – *Ordinance authorizing sale in Council*
 - Hole #13 at golf course – 1st phase being scheduled
 - 2014 Budget – staff working on proposed budget; Council workshop to be held Nov. 6
 - Health Insurance Renewal – Renewal amount due soon
- Water Tank Maintenance Program Contract

The contract for this 10 year program has been signed at an annual cost of \$40,446.00. Initial rehabilitation will take place in Spring, 2014.
- MORPC Regional Resurfacing Program

MORPC received \$1M for basic resurfacing road work from the federal government for roadwork within MORPC's area. This is an 80% grant/20% local match program for roads shown on the Federal-Aid System map. Our submission, Groveport Rd from SR317 to Saltzgaber, was recommended for funding. Our cost to repave this section will be \$11,264.
