Legislation

Res. 18-003 Intent to Reimburse the Street and Storm Water Funds for the Hamilton Road Firehouse Lane Intersection project

This legislation is required by OPWC when we will pay the contractor, then request that OPWC reimburses us for the payment for this project. We are asking for emergency legislation so that we can submit the paperwork to OPWC and begin the project.

Ord. 18-034 Fraternal Order of Police Union Contract

This legislation approves the contract for the FOP union officers. Negotiations have been completed and the members have voted to ratify the contract. Since the contract is retroactive for the period 07/01/18 through 06/30/21, we are requesting that legislation be adopted at this meeting as emergency legislation.

Ord. 18-035 Authorize a Contract with RITA for the Administration and Collection of Municipal Income Tax

This legislation authorizes a contract with RITA for the administration and collection of our income tax. While the conversion will begin immediately, the actual collection will begin on 01/01/2019. Because the City only became aware in late June that the City of Columbus will no longer administer our income tax collection effective 01/01/2019, we are requesting that the ordinance be adopted at tonight's meeting as emergency so that the conversion is as seamless as possible.
