PROGRESS TOWARD GOALS IN REPORTING PERIOD:

In the second quarter of 2020, Groveport Senior Transportation has served 55 unique individuals for a total of 77 for the first half. We have been able to continue our medical and personal transportation trips during the Pandemic using strict protocol in order to keep clients and employees safe. Despite the challenge of transporting clients during a pandemic, we are pleased with our progress toward our goal. We continue to be challenged with ways to keep our clients and employees safe while transporting our clients to medical and personal appointments. We feel we have a good protocol for keeping the buses clean and disinfected. We are masking and using gloves to clean. Employees are checking temperature and symptoms daily.

IDENTIFIED BARRIERS TO GOAL COMPLETION:

The Covid 19 Pandemic continues to create a challenge toward meeting the goal we set before the pandemic. Compared to this time last year, we are down 824 rides. We had 100 unique riders at the end of June 2019. We are at 77 unique riders at the end of June 2020 toward our goal of 105.
