

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT TO COUNCIL September 20, 2021

## **ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS**

- Cemetery operations
  - Headstone leveling program will start in the fall
    - Currently waiting on delivery of replacement concrete mixer
  - Created amendments to C.O. Chapter 137.02 Rules and Regulations of the Cemetery for additions, accuracy and consistency
- Main Street aesthetic enhancements
  - Fire hydrant painting including Storz adapter installation Completed
  - Street light painting is in progress
    - Completion scheduled in September 2021, pending weather and staff availability
  - o Traffic sign replacement program 2021 Completed
  - Traffic signal painting Completed
- Mosquito control program
  - Year to date eight rounds
    - June 1<sup>st</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>
    - July 21<sup>st</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>
    - August 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Rarey's Port & Wert's Grove
  - Located and inspected the existing sewer service laterals to verify condition; pipes were in good condition and able to be reused
  - Coordinated extension of water main in the middle of Main St north to accommodate water tap connection for Rarey's Port building
- Sidewalk replacement program 2021
  - o Harber Concrete is performing the sidewalk repairs in September
- Street tree maintenance
  - Started maintenance activities on the top one hundred trees based on the Priority Tree Maintenance Listing created by Davey Resource Group
    - Staff began removing thirty five hazardous trees throughout the community
    - Currently working on the replacement tree planting list for the fall season
    - Waiting on price quotes from two certified arborists for pruning sixty five trees
  - Created amendments to C.O. Chapter 911 Trees & Shrubs for flexibility, accuracy and consistency
- 2022 Budget preparations, including input from staff
