City Administrator Report to Council BJ King, City Administrator July 25, 2022

Legislation

Ord. 2022-025 - Code amendment related to fireworks by private residents

Approval of this ordinance would amend our code to prohibit fireworks to be shot by private residents to only the July 4th holiday. Governor Dewine signed House Bill 172, which permits residents to discharge consumer grade fireworks on nine different dates/holidays. House Bill 172 takes effect on July 1. This ordinance is scheduled for a 3rd reading on July 11th.

Ord. 2022-028 - Creation of Opioid Settlement Fund

The City has received our portion of the OneOhio Distributor Settlement (Opioid Settlement) in the amount of \$1,086. To account for this money, a fund must be created specific to the settlement funds. Our settlement money will be deposited into this new fund and any expenditures will be tracked accordingly. Since the City has received the settlement funds, we request that this ordinance be passed as an emergency so the money can be deposited into account.

Ord. 2022-029 – Code amendment to Codified Ordinance Chapter 929 – Water Regulations Approval of this ordinance would amend Codified Ordinance Chapter 929 – Water Regulations The changes reflect an update to the code to replace reference to "Public Works Superintendent" with "Public Services Director." This is simply an update to this code section to be consistent with our current organizational chart and position descriptions. This ordinance should be referred to the August 15th Committee if the Whole meeting.
