DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES – January 2026**

- **Membership Updates:**
  - The updated membership structure and fee schedule were officially implemented in January. Member feedback has been overwhelmingly positive, particularly regarding the convenience of the monthly recurring draft option and the flexibility to cancel at any time. This positive reception is reflected in a year-to-date increase in Rec Center revenue of \$9,636.21 compared to January 2025.
  
- **Rec Center Updates:**
  - Several facility enhancements were completed in January to improve the overall guest experience. Additions included a new air hockey table, foosball table, and shuffleboard table. These upgrades were made to create a more engaging and enjoyable environment for children, families, and adults.
  
- **Meetings/Special Events:**
  - **United Way Community Partnership Meeting (January 8):**  
Participated in a collaborative meeting with United Way and fellow local nonprofit organizations to discuss strategies for supporting students and families within the Groveport Madison School District.
  
  - **City of New Albany Tour:**  
Hosted representatives from the City of New Albany for a tour of the Recreation Center as they explore the potential development of a recreation facility in their community.
