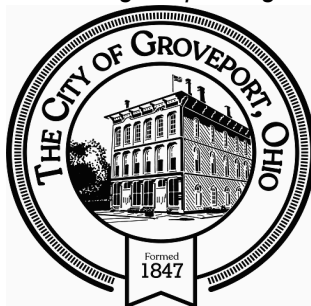

He said the purpose of the tax budget is to provide an estimate of unencumbered fund balances that we do predict for the calendar year 2024, which would be the attached Exhibit A. Also included is our outstanding indebtedness that we would have at the end of 2024. The amounts reported are estimates prepared as of today and will be used to help prepare the 2024 operating budget.
