**ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS**

- Director, Senior Grounds Worker & Street Superintendent held interviews for Parks Maintenance Worker position
- Equipment purchases
  - Public Works ordered new front end loader
- Facilities staff identified and performed maintenance tasks for the opening of the Aquatic Center
- Infrastructure asset and work order management
  - Configuration and implementation was completed March 2nd
  - Testing phase started mid-March with full roll out expected mid-April 2022
- Meetings (Director)
  - Met with all Parks staff individually to build working relationships
  - Met with Franklin County & several other jurisdictions to discuss Williams Rd improvement planning
  - Attended MORPC State of the Region banquet
  - Met with HVAC contractor to address climate control in Paddock Pub rooms
  - Met with Franklin County Health to discuss Groveport's mosquito control program
