City Administrator Report to Council BJ King, City Administrator July 11, 2022

Legislation

Ord. 2022-025 – Code amendment related to fireworks by private residents

Approval of this ordinance would amend our code to prohibit fireworks to be shot by private residents to only the July 4th holiday. Governor Dewine signed House Bill 172, which permits residents to discharge consumer grade fireworks on nine different dates/holidays. House Bill 172 takes effect on July 1. This ordinance is scheduled for a 3rd reading on July 11th.

Ord. 2022-026 - Establishing employment position as Classified/Unclassified

This ordinance would update our list of Classified/Unclassified positions of employment with the City. There are different hiring practices that have to occur for Classified and Unclassified employees. Positions designated as Classified are subject to a competitive scoring system to establish an eligibility list, which must ultimately be approved by the Personnel Board of Review. With the addition, and abolishment, of positions, it is necessary to update this list, which will serve as a guide for the future when determining the correct hiring process for positions. This ordinance was recommended for approval during the June 20th Committee meeting. The Administration will request an amendment to this ordinance during the July 11th Council meeting to add a few additional positions.

Ord. 2022-027 – Creation of part-time Assistant Clerk of Council position

Approval of this ordinance would result in the creation of a part-time Assistant Clerk of Council position. The workload of the Clerk of Council has increased due to absorbing the duties for creating agendas, clerking meetings and creating minutes for the Trees & Decoration Committee and the Cemetery Committee. This position would be assigned such duties, in addition to helping with fulfilling public records requests and managing legislation and Council packets. This position would also create a succession plan for when the current Clerk of Council ultimately retires. This position would be placed in pay grade 11, consistent with the Clerk of Council pay. The Administration requests emergency passage of this legislation in order to fill the position as quickly as possible.
