**Engineering Department – *Steve Farst***

• **Capital Projects:**

Alum Creek Drive at Rohr Road	Design underway. Construction to begin in 2020. Project led by Franklin County Engineer. Will include a widening of Rohr Road east to Port Rd.
Bixford Green Trail	Design underway. To be Bid this fall for 2020 construction.
Hamilton Rd at Firehouse Lane Intersection Imprvts	Paving completed on new southbound right-turn lane. Foundations installed for the new signal equipment, which is to be installed before mid-August.
E. Bixby Road Improvements	Preconstruction meeting held on June 19. Contractor is anticipating to begin work last week of July, which is when temporary closure of the road will begin, weather permitting. Improvement zone is Ebright Rd. intersection, east to US 33. Affected nearby residents have been notified via letter, and a detour route has been designated. City website also shows project information.

**Streets/Street:**

2019 Street Maintenance	Project out for bid by the Franklin County Engineer, who has prepared project specifications and scope.
Storm improvements	Design specs being included in Street program, to rehabilitate curb/gutter Bids will determine scope of improvement.

• **Development projects:**

Traffic Impact Study (TIS)	TIS is being reviewed, related to a potential development site at the NE corner of Rohr and Alum Creek Drive. This review is part of review of an application for Development Plan approval, that is to be presented to Planning Commission in August.
