• Capital Projects:

Alum Creek Drive and

Rohr Road to Port Rd Utility relocation underway. Construction soon to begin in June, 2020.

W. Bixby Rd., Phase 2 Design underway. 50% plan received and under review.

Bixford Green Trail Work substantially complete. Walk through was conducted on May 29.

Intersection improvements

Construction underway. Work now has shifted to the south side of the street). It is expected that this phase of the project will be completed before

end of July. The Phase 2 plan, is under review at 100% stage. Phase 2 will

be advertised for construction bids after July 1.

Streets/Street:

2020 Street Maintenance Paving and shoulder treatments have been completed on Old Hamilton

Road and on Bixby Road, which is now reopened to traffic. On Glendening Drive, majority of work is complete: Curb removal and reconstruction, curb ramps, drive aprons, walk repairs, and road pavement removal and resurfacing are all complete. On Glendening, the push-button activated flashing crosswalk assembly is yet to be installed. Striping is soon to occur. The next phase will include work at the intersection of Main Street and College to mill and resurface asphalt, install drainage improvement, correct ADA ramps and sidewalks and add Streetprint cross-walks. This activity at Main and College will likely occur after July 4. All work is ahead of the official schedule deadline. Project information is on our

website.

Main St. at Front St. Our contractor Strawser Co. has returned and during the week of June 8

through June 17, the Streetprint crosswalks are being installed.

2400 Rohr Rd Site development plans and new infrastructure plans are under review for
