Administrative items

- Food trucks I anticipate that a motion will be made during the June 22nd Council meeting to temporarily suspend the enforcement of police and zoning requirements for food trucks in residential areas (driveways and roadside). The temporary suspension of enforcement would allow for residents and neighborhoods to host food trucks while the City works to potentially permanently amend our code to permit food trucks in residential areas.
- Mosquito treatment We are scheduled to complete a second city-wide mosquito treatment on Sunday, June 21st. Spraying will begin between 8:30 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. in the area of the warehouses. The entire city will be sprayed again. Additionally, we plan to spray the golf course. Our first city-wide treatment was well received by the community.
