***Legislation***

Ord. 19-028 School Speed Zone for Groveport-Madison High School (3<sup>rd</sup> Reading)

As part of the on-going Hamilton Road – Firehouse Lane project, the school requested a 20 mph school zone for restricted hours be enacted for the high school. We have received approval for this from ODOT as long as we follow the standard 20 mph speed limit. If approved, this will be done in conjunction with the new School Zone flasher system.

Ord. 19-033 Parking Restrictions on Amalgamated Place (1<sup>st</sup> Reading)

This legislation will not allow parking on the non-hydrant side of Amalgamated Place, including the cul-de-sac. No parking signs had been erected, but someone removed them. Staff has researched to find the original legislation, but was unable to find the legislation. This was requested by the police department. They provided photos showing parking throughout the street and cul-de-sac, which would limit fire vehicles from the immediate area. Because this is a safety issue, emergency language has been added, and we are requesting all three readings at tonight's meeting.

Ord. 19-034 Prepare and Submit an Application to OPWC for the West Bixby Road Rehabilitation Phase II Project and Execute All Associated Contracts (1<sup>st</sup> Reading)

This project would be the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of a three-phase project to upgrade West Bixby Road, following the recent Phase I grant project.

Ord. 19-036 Prepare and Submit an Application to OPWC for the South Hamilton Rd/Higgins Blvd./Directors Blvd. Intersection Project and to Execute all Associated Agreements (1<sup>st</sup> Reading)

This is the for the intersection portion of the improvements required for the Pizzuti project.

***Miscellaneous***

Kronos Time and Attendance Program – After reviewing presentations from multiple vendors, the staff has reviewed and recommended the system to replace the ADP system we currently use (see my July 8 report). The Finance Director is leading the efforts for the implementation of this program.
