- **Capital Projects:**

2024 Street Maintenance Paving is complete on all streets that were part of this year's program. Additional curbing is to be addressed this month. Aside from that work is substantially complete.

Pickle Ball Courts Work is substantially complete and courts are open for use. Punch list items are identified and are being addressed.

Emergency Generators Work progresses. Generators are in place. Gas service meters are installed and Bixford PS/Elmont PS testing and start-up is expected to occur in next couple weeks. It is expected work will be completed by end of October.

Intersection Improvements The OPWC funding application for roadway improvements was filled with SR 317 at Firehouse Lane MORPC on August 30. Presentation will be made to the integrating committee in October. The outcome will be known in December '24.
