Engineering Department – *Steve Farst*

- **Capital Projects:**

Alum Creek Drive and Rohr Road to Port Rd	Construction suspended until Spring. Project managed by Franklin County Engineers office (FCEO)
W. Bixby Rd., Phase 2	Design underway. Coordinating with impacted property owners for easements and for Railroad cooperation. This project, funded by OPWC will bid in late winter 2021.
Phase 2 S. Hamilton/Higgins Intersection Improvements	Construction suspended until Spring. The left turn lane improvements are open to traffic. In the Spring, final paving and traffic signal equipment is expected to be installed before May 2021.

Streets/Street:

2021 Street Maintenance	Evaluating work scope and moving into design process. Streets to be included will be identified in future reports.
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Storm:

Alley Drainage	Study and design is proceeding to address condition and possible replacement of older alley storm tiles north of Main Street. Improvements potentially to be included with the 2021 Street maintenance activities.
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- **Development Projects:**

Redwood Apts. Hendron	Engineering plans for site development and utility improvements are under review.
2400 Rohr Rd	Site development plans and new infrastructure plans are under review for this site located at the NE corner of Rohr Rd. and Alum Creek Drive. Mass grading is expected to begin in a couple months.
5770 Saltzgaber Rd	Site development and utility line construction is underway.
Eastland-Fairfield School	Construction proceeds on the Aviation Tech building and site work.
