**Legislation:**

2016 Capital Purchases and Projects – A series of ordinances have been requested for capital purchases and projects included in the 2016 Appropriations. These include:

- Solicit bids and contract for Wirt Road Phase II Pedestrian Bike Path, 2016 Street Maintenance Program, painting of indoor pool ceiling and walls, and wellfield improvements

*\*\*We are requesting suspending the rules to allow for two readings so that we can advertise for the Wirt Road and Street Maintenance projects shortly after the first of the year. \*\**

- Enter into a lease agreement with Huntington Bank and purchase, through the state purchasing program, 2 police cruisers and ancillary equipment, a 1-Ton dump truck, a single-axle 25-Ton dump truck, and 1 rough mower

- Enter into a lease agreement with Huntington Bank and purchase 1 pick-up truck, 1 Cushman trickster, and 1 Tiger cub mower

- Request qualification and enter into a contract for the engineering and design for a facility replacing the old water treatment plant

- Enter into a leasing arrangement with Huntington Bank for all of the above

The ordinances related to personnel changes (2 additional police officers, Engineering Administrative Assistant, and 2 FT front desk personnel at the Rec Center will be introduced the first meeting in January.

Playground Equipment – Founders Bend Neighborhood Park

The equipment has been delivered and is being stored for the Winter. Construction will occur in March, 2016.
