

FACILITIES and PARKS STATUS

November 17, 2014

- Work has wrapped up on the 2015 Budget
- New signage at City Park locations with information regarding; park hours and rules. All signs have been installed.
- The Energy Audit Project is beginning to wind down with regard to the electrical and mechanical systems. Dynamix Engineering continues to work on software issues and building communication systems. All readings indicate that the city is doing very well in energy cost savings.
- Work has been completed on the shelter house at Blacklick Park. New roof shingles have been applied along with repairs made to rotting wood.
- The Parks Department has been working on Fall fertilizer and pond maintenance. Work continues on the sports fields and the pond pumps are now removed.
- Work has begun in the Police Station. We will be doing some upgrades to the heating and cooling systems. We will also add the building to the Building Management System as part of the Energy Audit Project.
- I have applied for a new gate opener with Bureau of Workers Comp. the gate is at the entrance of the Public Works Facility. The grant will cover 75% of the cost of the solar powered gate opener. We should hear back from the BWC next week.
- The Parks Department is preparing for the winter season. We will be purchasing salt and inspecting equipment, let's hope it's a mild winter.

- We had McKee Door Company in at the Public Works Building to inspect and do preventive maintenance on all 10 of the overhead doors. McKee will be back in to make some additional repairs
- We brought Minton Doors in to inspect the front doors at the Municipal Building. The doors will be replaced within the next 4 weeks.
