Events

The Community Affairs elves have been busy getting the building ready for Storytime @ Town Hall, spreading Christmas cheer on Giving Tuesday, hosting elementary school students, setting up the gingerbread house display, and planning a fun evening for A Heritage Holiday.

<u>Giving Tuesday</u> – On November 30, staff distributed 144 gift bags to our senior residents containing blank cards, fuzzy socks, large print word search, calendar, tissues, lotion, gripper/jar opener, fruit, and a candy cane. The Transportation Department shuttled Town Hall staff to Senior Village and Greenfield Place. Lt. Josh Short made deliveries to 37 residences in Groveport proper.

<u>A Heritage Holiday</u> – This Saturday, December 11 from 5pm to 8pm is A Heritage Holiday in Heritage Park. The Parks Department and Town Hall staff have been working together to create an extra festive experience. Something new this year: Town Hall will be open this Saturday from 2pm to 4:30pm for anyone wanting to see the gingerbread display, or hear a Christmas story upstairs in the ballroom, before heading to A Heritage Holiday.

Storytime @ Town Hall – Groveport Elementary students have been enjoying taking a field trip to Town Hall for a gingerbread house scavenger hunt and storytime. We have a total of 16 classes, K - 5, visiting Town Hall during the 2-week storytime.
