Legislation:

Accept Bids and Authorize Contracts for “Hillside” Project (1st Reading)

When we discussed the various work to be performed as part of the hillside project at the Committee of the Whole, Kevin suggested that you could wait and vote on the 2016 Appropriations with the project as shown or without a portion of the project. However, working backward from project completion, in order to complete the project prior to the busiest time of the season, we would need to begin the project no later than March 1 (the earlier the better). In order to allow the time necessary to order product for the project, we are looking at a contract award and notice to proceed date of the first week of January after advertising the project beginning mid-November. This requires this legislation to be effective by then.

Authorize Administrator to Bid and Execute Contracts for Wellfield Improvements (2nd Reading)

This project will purchase and install a permanent generator at the well field, with installation of a gas line to feed the generator for power. This project is included in our 2015 Appropriations. We delayed the project until after completion of the water treatment plant.

Health Services Contract with Franklin County Health District (2nd Reading)

The contract applies to our normal services, and includes a 5% cost increase to \$42,058.66.

2016 Appropriations (2nd Reading)

Thanks to everyone for the great discussion and comments regarding the 2016 Budget. Per Council Members’ requests 1) Steve Farst and Tom Byrne are determining cost estimates to pave the lower gravel parking lot at the recreation center, and 2) Tom Walker will provide additional discussion points regarding the reconfiguration of Hole #9 and additional parking spaces at the golf course.
