Green aerifcation went very well and greens have completely healed.

The annual deep tinning of greens is tentatively scheduled for the middle of November.

Cart path replacement continues. All sections of the path north of Little Walnut Creek have been milled and stoned. Only #15, 16, 17, and 18 have been capped with Asphalt so far. I have stressed to the contractor that I'm concerned about lack of progress on Asphalt placement heading into the fall. At some point weather will require carts to be path only and the lack of Asphalt will hinder that. I'm hoping to get a definitive answer to a schedule this week.

As Administrator King indicated in his last report the cost of range balls has significantly increase for 2023, from \$5.50 a dozen to \$9.00 a dozen. I was planning to recommend an increase after researching what courses are charging for range balls but the cost increase from the supplier confirmed an increase in necessary. Other course are charging \$18.00 for a large and we're changing \$12.00. I'm recommending an increase to \$16.00 for a large (now \$12.00), \$12.00 for a medium (now \$9.00), and \$8.00 for a small (now \$5.00)
