- Out of Office

- OPBA Negotiations

We have begun negotiating with the Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Assoc. on behalf of the Police Sergeants for a contract. We have future sessions scheduled for March 19 and 24.

- Town Center Project

The pad for the buildings should be ready to begin construction no later than May 1.

- Police Building/MB Improvements

The police building is now occupied with a temporary occupancy permit. There are just a few “clean up” items being completed. The old police area of the MB is moving right along.

- Reimbursement Resolution Legislation for Water Treatment Plant Project

I had the pre-bid meeting and the bid opening for this project moved forward to March 12 and April 4 respectively in order to allow Council time to resolve the passage of this legislation.

Hopefully, this will provide you with enough time to resolve your issues so that we do not have to cancel this bid, then re-advertise and re-bid
