- Park and Pond Update

Three areas of concerns:

 - 1) Signage – We have inventoried all park signage and are in the process of determining what new signage is needed..
 - 2) Palm Pond condition – We are investigating a permanent solution to this problem.
 - 3) Rules – We are reviewing our rules as they compare to ODNR/State rules to determine what rules need modified, if any.

- Bond Legislation

The bond for the water treatment plant construction is in the amount of \$2,800,000. This includes the actual bid amount of \$2,597,000, \$39,000 for Add Alternate #1 and \$164,000 for construction management and engineering. The engineer’s estimate was \$2,450,000 plus \$40,000 for Add Alternate #1. The construction includes the installation of the Hamilton Road PRV vault, and Add Alternate #1 is for the re-construction of a waterline on-site.

The bond for the police and municipal buildings is in the amount of \$900,000; \$100,000 less than the original note. It is our plan to pay down \$100,000 each year.
